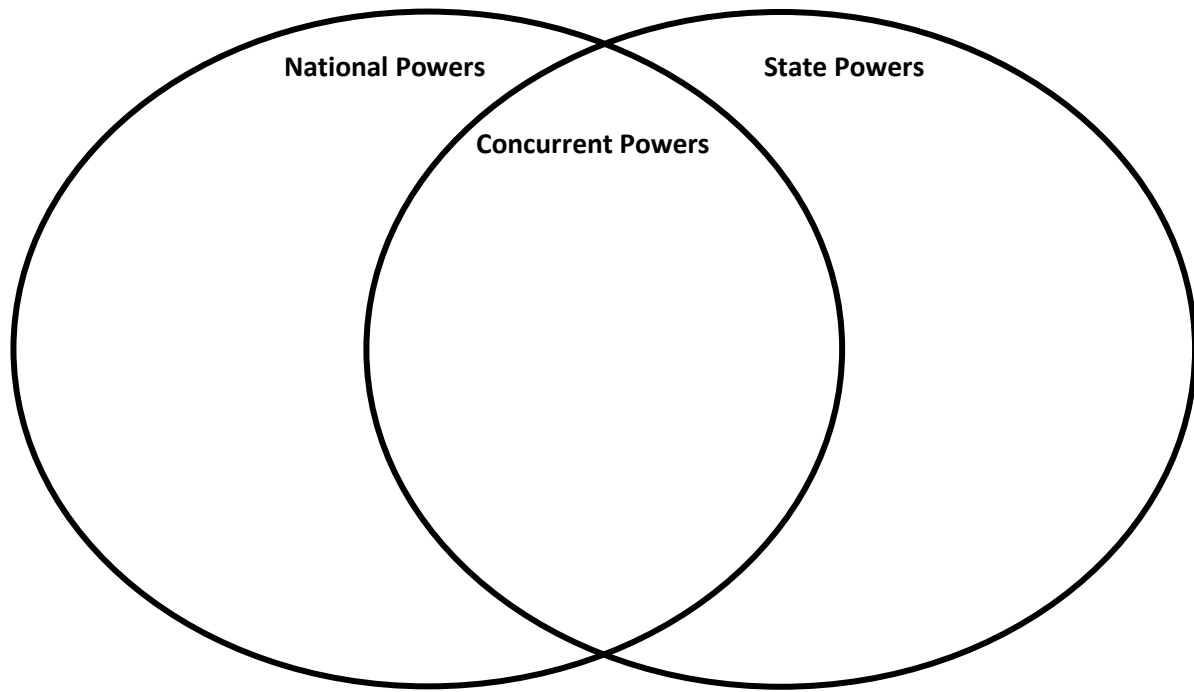


Division of Powers

Part A. Use the Constitution or other resources to help you determine which level of government has each power. Write the corresponding number in the correct location on the Venn diagram below.

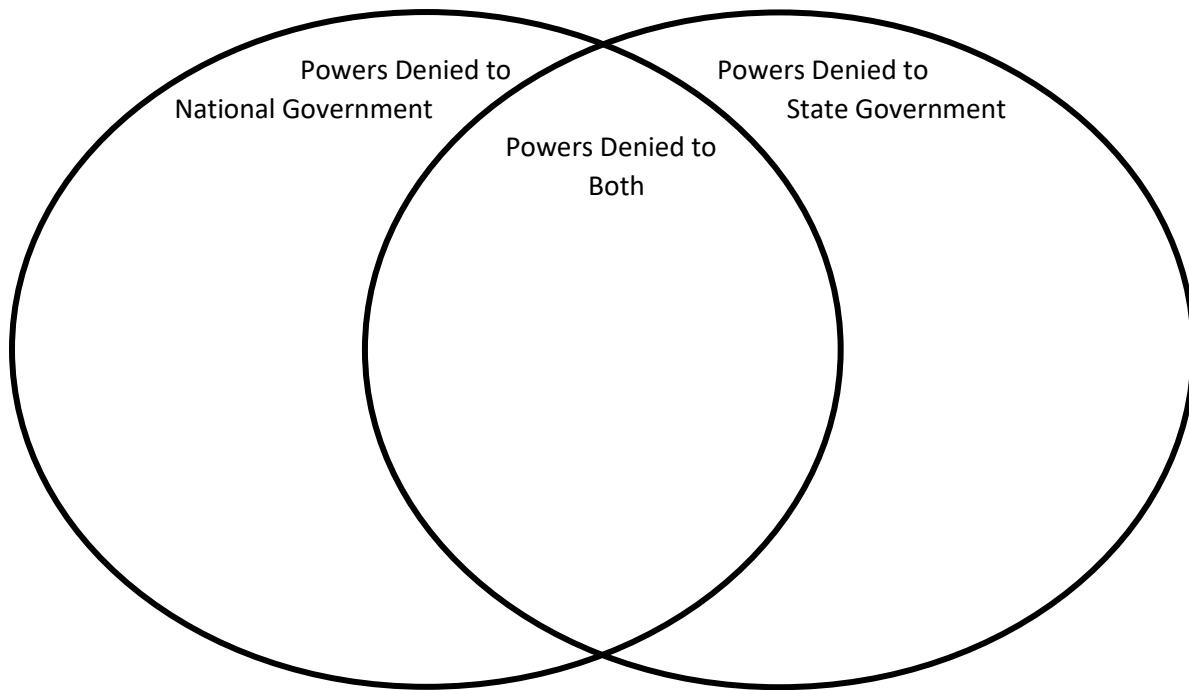
