Background on Edison

- Born February 11, 1847
- One of first inventors to use mass-production
 - First research laboratory
- Telegraph operator
 - Led to a system of electric-power generation and distribution

Major Invention

- The light bulb
- Referred to today as "The Edison Bulb"

- Electricity in homes and shops is introduced
- Artisans could work later hours, more things accomplished
- Not all work done by sun/candle/fire light
