## **EXAMPLES OF JOB INTERVIEW QUESTIONS**

In this exercise, we will focus on an interview for nursing or medical position. It's always a good idea to review typical interview questions and answers for the type of job you are applying for.

## I. <u>Tips for Answering:</u>

- 1. Reflexione sobre las preguntas y la forma en que debe responder.

- 3. When giving your answer, use an example of when you encountered a similar situation that had a successful outcome.
- 4. Your response should be expressed positively by highlighting your attributes

## II. Questions:

- 1. What made you choose nursing as a career?
  - a. Dealing with patients and their families, and helping them through what is often a difficult time for them is extremely satisfying for me.
- 2. Tell me about yourself.
  - a. Recommendation: Sharing too much or too little information isn't a good idea.
  - b. Starting out by sharing some personal interests which don't relate directly to your work. For example, include a hobby which you are passionate.
    - i. I am passionate about beekeeping. I love bees because they bring great benefit to the environment and the health of people.
- 3. What interests you about working here?
  - a. Your facility has one of the top-rated cardiac units in the country, and I am interested in utilizing my experience with cardiac patients in a hospital engaging in the latest research and techniques.
  - b. I really enjoy working as nurse, and your facility has and innovative reputation for its programs and population.
- 4. What is the most you like about being a nurse?
  - a. What I am most passionate about nursing is that I can serve people who need support in the healing process. Their health is compromised and they need us to help them through the difficult situation.
- 5. What is the most difficult part of being a nurse?

- a. The most difficult part is when I have a patient that is very unhappy, or in a lot of pain, and I can't comfort them to the degree I'd like.
- 6. How would you handle stress on the job?
  - a. I handle stress by focusing on the most important thing, the care of the patient. I feel I owe it to my patients to stay calm and focused on them.
- 7. Would you describe yourself as organized?
  - a. Yes, sometimes a little too much so. I make sure that everything is neat and in order.
