Step-by-Step Class Instructions

1. Place the List of Traits on the board one at a time. For each trait discuss what that looks like at SCHOOL and what that would look like for a CAREER. Make a T chart on the Board. One side of chart being School and other side being Career.
2. Once all traits are discussed write the sentence: I am TRUSTWORTHY when _____.
3. Model filling in the sentence and drawing a picture.
4. Have students pick 2 character traits and write the sentence and draw a picture of themselves showing that at SCHOOL and for a CAREER.
