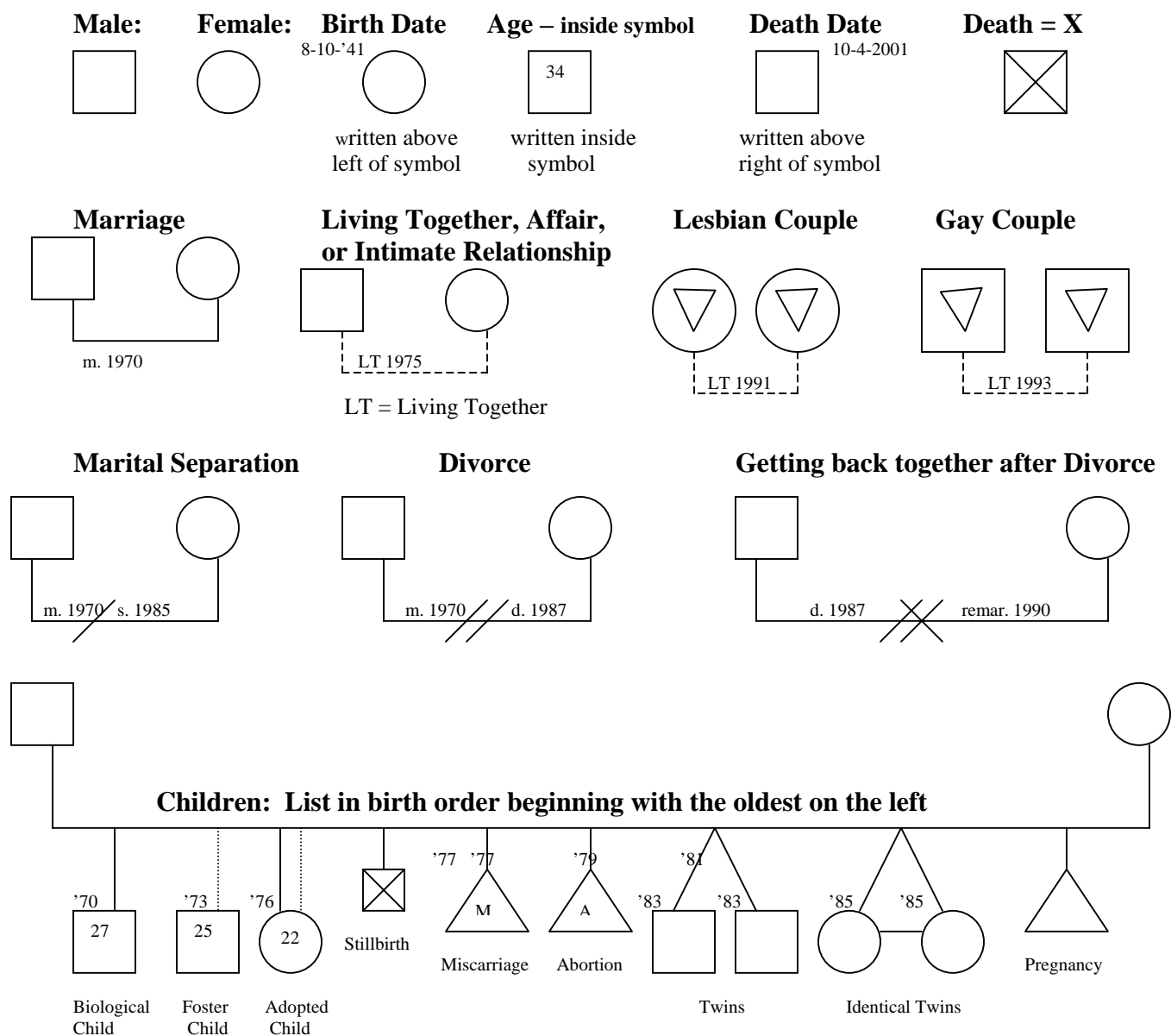


The Basic Genogram Symbols

- Children are drawn left to right, going from the oldest to the youngest.

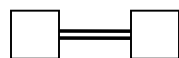

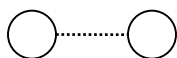

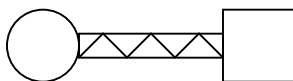

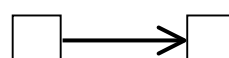

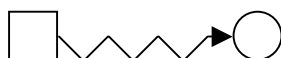
