- 1. **stereotype** (noun)- a widely held but fixed and oversimplified image or idea of a particular type of person or thing.
- 2. **ethnic stereotype -** (national stereotype, or national character) is a system of beliefs about typical characteristics of members of a given ethnic group or nationality, their status, society and cultural norms.
- 3. **gender** (noun)- the state of being male or female. 'Gender' also refers to the social roles, behaviors and traits that a society may assign to men (masculine) or to women (feminine)
- 4. **gender stereotype** -Preconceived ideas whereby females and males are arbitrarily assigned characteristics and roles determined and limited by their gender.
- 5. **bias** (noun)- prejudice in favor of or against one thing, person, or group compared with another, usually in a way considered to be unfair.
- 6. **belief** (noun)- an acceptance that a statement is true or that something exists.
- 7. harmfulness (noun) -causing or capable of causing harm
