Big Ideas

- All behaviors come from unmet needs
- Shared Decision Making minimizes
systemic vulnerabilities
- A family driven plan can be just as
effective as a professionally driven plan

Timelines

- Team membership building starts ASAP
- Initial CFT meeting must occur before 1st 60 days
- Meetings beyond Initial must be as needed and
can be called by any team member
- Must occur no later than every 90 Days
