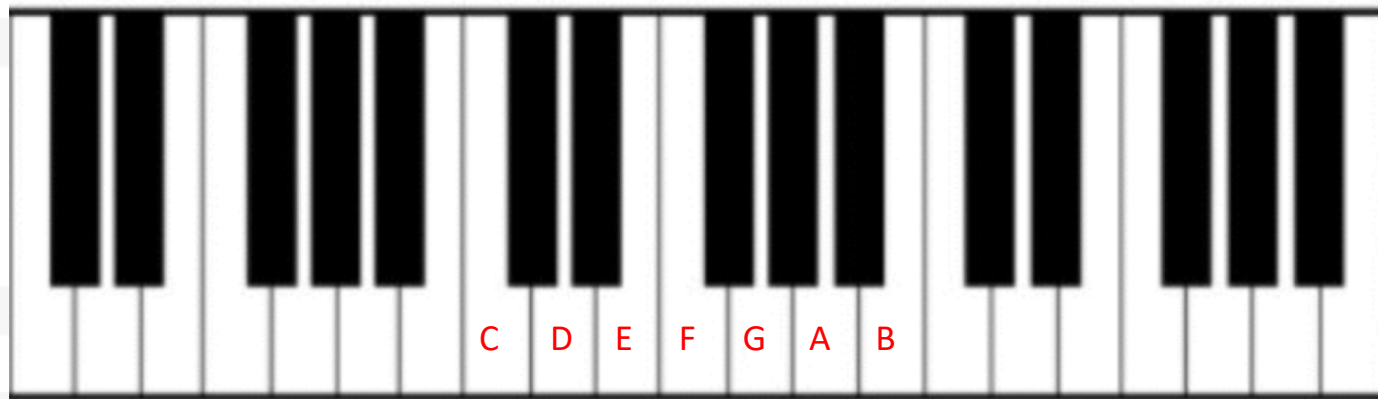


# HALF STEPS AND WHOLE STEPS

whole step = a distance of two keys

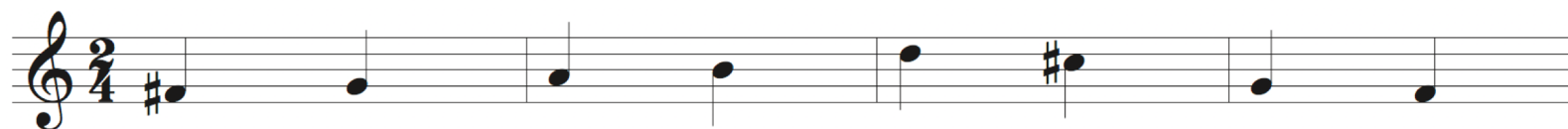
half step = a distance of one key

|------------------------------|---|---|---|---|---|---|----|----|
| Number of sharps in each key | 0 | 1 | 2 | 3 | 4 | 5 | 6  | 7  |

order of flats: B E A D G C F

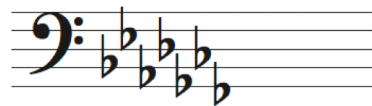
| Order of keys with flats    | C | F | Bb | Eb | Ab | Db | Gb | Cb |
